Dr. Phil O'Connor was President of PROactive Strategies, a Chicago consulting firm providing advice in the energy and insurance industries. For three decades Phil has been recognized as a leading advocate of competitive market solutions in regulated industries. He has published and spoken widely on the subject.

As chairman of the Illinois Commerce Commission in the early 1980s, he was the first utility regulator to present a plan for a transition to a wholesale and competitive electricity industry and was an early supporter of interstate gas pipeline open access and wellhead price deregulation.
